



TERMS OF SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Fields of study covered by this scholarship are architecture, engineering, construction, and related disciplines.
- 2. A check will be issued in the fall of each year to the student's college for the yearly scholarship award. The payment shall be made in 2 consecutive annual installments, or until the student graduates from a four-year program, whichever comes first.
- 3. The student must claim the first payment of the scholarship not more than two years after the date the scholarship is awarded. Once the student has requested the first scholarship payment, the student has five years within which to claim all scholarship payments.
- 4. For the student's first year, the college shall provide ACE with confirmation of the student's enrollment, his/her selected major, and instructions for issuing the scholarship check.
- 5. For each year thereafter, the college shall provide ACE with a statement that the student is in good academic standing, as defined by the college catalog, in addition to the information listed in Item #3.
- 6. The student may change colleges without affecting the scholarship.
- 7. To avoid forfeiting the remainder of the scholarship, the student must remain in good academic standing, must continue in the field of study in architecture, engineering, construction management or related field, and his/her college must annually provide to ACE the information requested above.
- 8. It is the student's responsibility, each year, to inform his/her college of the terms of this scholarship, to request that the college provide ACE with the required information, and to ensure its receipt by ACE.
- 9. It is the student's responsibility to provide bi-annual progress updates via email to washingtondc@acementor.org during the course of this scholarship award.
